Passing the Respect for Marriage Act

The U.S. Senate has an opportunity to provide a massive win for LGBTQIA+ families by passing the Respect for Marriage Act, which would solidify the freedom to marry for same-sex and interracial couples under federal law. Now, we need your help to make it a reality.

The bill has already passed the House of Representatives by a vote of 267 to 157. Support poured in from both sides of the aisle, with 47

Anti-LGBTQIA+ efforts are doubling their attacks and telling Senators the exact opposite of what the public desires. The fact is that support for the freedom to marry is at an all-time high of 71% support, according to a recent Gallup poll. Americans from all walks of life, across demographics, geographies, and party lines agree that loving, committed couples have the right to be respected and protected under the law. We need our legislators to step up and vote in line with public opinion.

The Respect for Marriage Act is an important opportunity to protect families who remain vulnerable to discrimination in their daily lives. And, of course, even after we protect the freedom to marry, it will be critical to continue pushing for federal nondiscrimination protections so our community is protected in ALL aspects of our lives.

We have a real chance to pass the Respect for Marriage Act this month - but we can't do it without your support. Your Senators need to hear from you: Take 2 minutes to tell your Senator to protect the freedom to marry for ALL Americans. Click here to take action.

The Rainbow Rose Center currently has openings for a Programs Committee Chair and Resources Committee Chair. Details for the two positions are provided below:

Programs Committee Chair Description -

The Programs Committee develops and moderates programs that promote the health and wellbeing of York County's LGBTQIA+ community. The Programs Committee identifies gaps in service to determine which programs to establish in order to fill those needs, whether through partnerships with other organizations or through original programming efforts.

Resources Committee Chair Description -

The Resources Committee finds and vets resources that benefit York County's LGBTQIA+ community. The Resources Committee establishes a vetting process to ensure that the resources are both knowledgeable and respectful of the LGBTQIA+ community, and/or recommends the resources to the Rainbow Rose Center's Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion (DEI) Training series. Vetted resources must be competent in handling the LGBTQIA+ community's care with the dignity and respect they deserve so that the Rainbow Rose Center would be comfortable and in good faith able to recommend the resources. The Resources Committee maintains a list of resources, broken out by type, and presents that list to the Board of Directors on a regular basis.

With the smoking rate within our community being nearly double that of the general population, more members of the LGBTQIA+ community are at greatly increased risk of lung cancer and chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD). We will continue to host Smoke-Free events, work with our schools to keep tobacco out of our youth's hands, and work with you to help you quit by connecting you to resources such as WellSpan's Freedom From Smoking® program.



This free, 8-week tobacco cessation program is designed by the American Lung Association to help quit tobacco use. Registration is required by calling (800) 840-5905 or register online at <u>WellSpan.org</u>.

All sessions are held online via Zoom.
