

As we kick off Pride Month today, we must remember that Pride began as a fight for our civil rights. That fight continues today -

Today, advocacy comes in many forms, but **we must all** community members and allies - take steps to ensure our rights are not revoked.



On May 31st, over 100 people expanded their knowledge on how to protect LGBTQIA+ Youth at the standing-room-only **York PA LGBTQIA+ Town Hall**. The Rainbow Rose Center was honored to join <u>The Trevor Project</u>, <u>PFLAG National</u>, and over 30 local and regional co-sponsors to host this event at York College of Pennsylvania's Marketview Arts. The event included a policy update on the current status of conversion therapy bans and practices in the United States, a panel of experts on the subject from both our own York community and the wider Central PA region, and a Q/A session, along with networking opportunities both before and after the event.

The day started with advocacy, with the three event cohosts and <u>THE VALLEY: For Good Change</u> founder Matthew Jackson meeting with <u>95th District Representative Carol</u> <u>Hill-Evans</u>, <u>York City Council</u> President Sandie Walker and Member Betsy W. Buckingham, along with Chief of Staff

Scott Miller, a City Attorney, and <u>York City Human</u> <u>Relations Commission</u>'s Executive Director Clare Twomey and Miguel Soto. Together we discussed the dangers of socalled conversion therapy and why York City should be the first in the South Central PA region to ban such practices. We will continue these conversations, and we hope to see them come to a productive close with a city-wide ban later this year.




