



Your voice matters! Nationally and locally, we're seeing the LGBTQIA+ community facing laws and potential laws taking away rights for no other reason than who we love. By voting, you can stop this hatred and secure rights for everyone. - 1. The last day to register to vote before the April Primary is Monday, April 8.
- 2. You must request a ballot by Tuesday, April 16 to vote by mail.
- 3. Primary Day in Pennsylvania is Tuesday, April 23, 2024.
