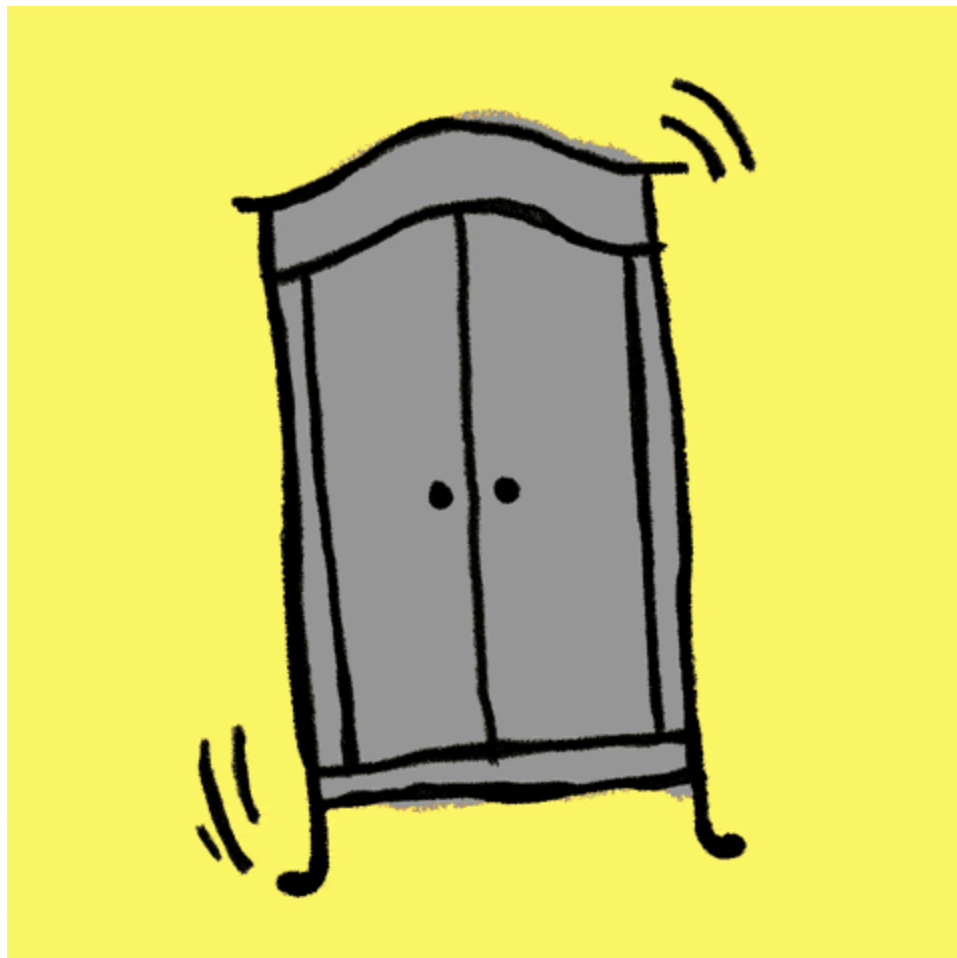

For members of the LGBTQIA+ community, finding clothing can be a huge challenge. We are more likely to struggle with self-worth, less likely to feel safe in clothing stores and changing rooms, and experience poverty at a higher rate than our peers. We believe that everyone deserves the opportunity to find a look that reflects their inner selves in a safe and supportive environment. However, meeting other individuals who are HIV positive that share the same concerns, fears and medical issues can reduce and relieve stress from the daily challenges of living with HIV. The HIV support group allows individuals living with HIV to come together to discuss the challenges they face so they do not have to face them alone, reducing physical and emotional isolation.

The current political climate and the rise in mental health issues exacerbated by the pandemic has driven the need for a group specifically tailored to *Queer and Transgender Black, Indigenous, and people of color (BIPOC)*. BIPOC and LGBTQIA+ individuals disproportionately experience biases, structural hurdles, and barriers to treatment and quality care. This monthly peer-led support group is an outlet for LGBTQIA+ People of Color to come together for open discussion in a space that strives to be safe and judgment free.

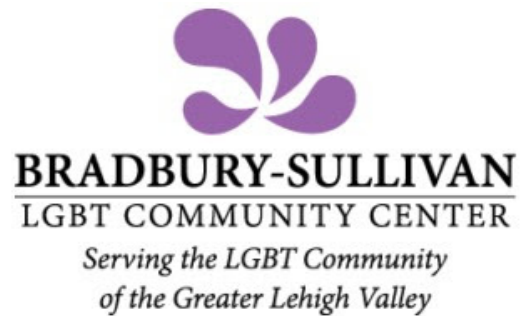

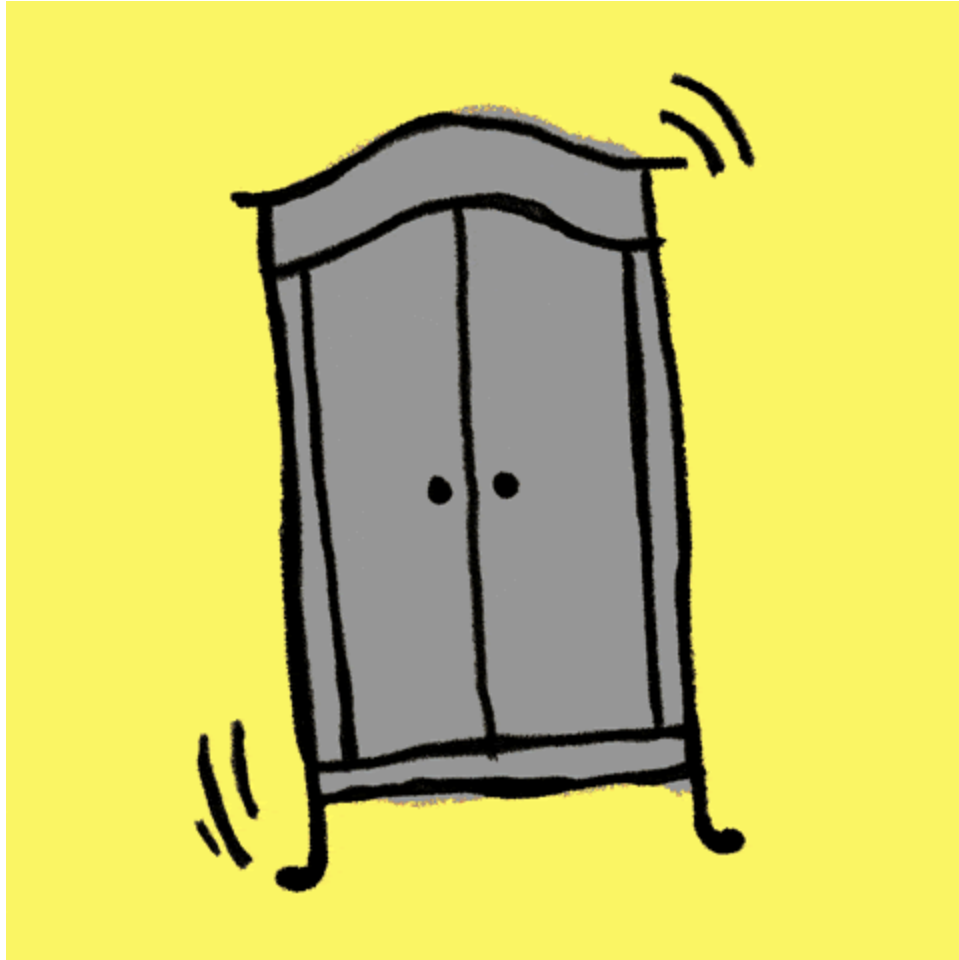
