I cannot believe how Rainbow Rose Center has grown in just two years! We went from meeting in the basement of the IDEAS Center in 2019 to establishing our first Board of Directors in 2020 to today- nearly two years into being an official nonprofit organization. Throughout it all, we have seen this amazing York Community embracing us and getting behind our initiatives. We cannot thank you enough for your support and your engagement!

Here is a brief reflection on 2021:

We initiated variety of new programs and services that benefit the community. Our Programs Committee formed support

Progress Council to help people at risk of losing their homes or utilities apply for the Emergency Rental Assistance Program. Our Preferred Partnership Program connected our supporters, allies, and the York LGBTQIA+ community with local, likeminded consumer businesses and organizations. Our Resource Specialists helped numerous transgender folx legally change their names, and our traveling clothing closet helped those in need find new, affirming outfits through generous community donations. All of these initiatives, combined with the continuation of our existing programs, allowed us to reach more than 500 members of the LGBTQIA+ community in need.

We put on some fantastic events this past year thanks in large part to our Preferred Partners, Sponsors, and the wonderful community we love to celebrate! We proudly followed the guidance of the Center for Disease Control and Prevention, the Pennsylvania Department of Health, and Governor Wolf by hosting our inaugural York County Pride event virtually, while still hosting several in-person small group events throughout the month of June. During 2021 we took every opportunity to safely gather in person: from the joyous Coming Out Day Celebration and Blessing to the somber and moving Transgender Day of Remembrance event. We were glad to see so many of you this year, and we appreciate everyone who engaged with our events, whether in person or virtually!

We hit some major milestones this past year that we couldn't be more excited about. First, we participated in Give Local York for the first time and met our goal of raising \$10k in 24 hours! We were the proud recipients of the Keystone Business Alliance 2021 Advocate of the Year Award and Downtown First Award for 2021 Outstanding Nonprofit Organization! We couldn't have made it this far without all of your support, generosity, and participation.

As we head into 2022, we will continue to foster an environment of inclusion, equity, and health where all LGBTQIA+ community members thrive in York County, Pennsylvania. We will certainly have challenges ahead, and we look forward to facing them head on with our community's backing. We know that together, we can

Rainbow Rose Center Reveals Our Core Values!

In November, the Rainbow Rose Center Board of Directors engaged in a Strategic Planning session moderated by CenterLink, an organization founded to support the development

thorough Strategic Plan to guide our organization in the coming year, we created our organizational Core Values. They are as follows:

Inclusion: We embody and advocate for justice, fairness, and acceptance for all, especially those who are often silenced.

Community Engagement Committee

We're all fired up for 2022 and looking forward to attending more events, meeting more people, and finding new ways to give back to our community. We're already packing our calendars full of the festivals and events we hope to attend, and have plans to train more volunteers to extend our presence even further. In 2021 we started up The Clothing Closet - our traveling clothing pantry designed to put free, gender-affirming clothing into the hands of our community. Thanks to a generous grant from the York County Community Foundation, we plan on expanding this program. This year we hope to hold more events and to provide supplies like wigs, binders, and other necessities directly to

We were grateful to partner with so many wonderful venues in 2021 to host our various events! Thank you to the Appel Center for Performing Arts for hosting our inaugural York County Pride stream, to People's Bank Park and the York Revolutions for having another fantastic Pride at the Ballpark event, for White Rose Bar & Grill and Out & About for hosting our Coming Out Day Celebration, Union Lutheran for the Coming Out Day Blessing, and to DreamWrights Center for Community Arts for hosting the Transgender Day of Remembrance. And thank you to all the businesses and restaurants that made York particularly Prideful in June to coincide with our events!

We are looking forward to hosting York County Pride on June 11, 2022, and are working on getting an in-person venue that meets the needs of our diverse community.

Fundraising Committee

The fundraising committee had a successful year in 2021. With the support of our community we raised over 35k in 2021 through sponsorship sales to the virtual York County Pride event, Give Local York, and the Rainbow Run 5K - all inaugural events for the Rainbow Rose Center and the community! We look forward to building upon this success in 2022 by introducing an annual sponsorship program, growing Give Local York, continuing with the Rainbow Run race, and by introducing new fundraising activities, to include an art show and sale. The Fundraiser Committee is also looking for new members. An ideal member is either someone with creative behind-the-scenes ideas for raising money OR someone who has the connections

Marketing and Communications Committee

This past year we've implemented the *Rainbow Connection*, our monthly newsletter, and we are really grateful for our volunteer who has consistently organized, edited, and published it on behalf of our Marketing & Communications Committee. We have worked on having more consistent communication with the community, with regular posts online and keeping our website updated.

We are also working really hard behind the scenes to get three new groups up and running next year. First off we are going to continue to develop our All Adult Identities support group and social outlet by having more consistent meetings with both educational and fun opportunities. The first new program we will introduce in the spring of 2022 is our Silver Triangle Group, which will cater to LGBTQIA+ adults ages 50+. Later in the year we plan to start up a program specifically for families where parents who have LGBTQIA+ identifying children younger than 14 can come and meet other parents, while their children make new affirming friends their age! We will also be creating a partner support group for the significant others of the Transgender folx participating in our ongoing Transgender Support Group meetings. We are so excited for 2022 and for our wonderful Rainbow Rose Center Community to be a part of it all!

Resources Committee

At the Rainbow Rose Center, we aim to refer our clients only to the resources we know and trust. That means the Resources Committee has to do our due diligence! We vet doctors, therapists, lawyers, businesses, organizations, religious spaces, and more to find out where our LGBTQIA+ community can feel safe, welcome, and affirmed. In 2021 we implemented the Preferred Partnership program to help with this goal, and in 2022 we plan to extend our outreach into all areas of our community and to all types of resources so that you will have confidence that your care will be handled with the dignity and respect you deserve!


