Diversity matters, and it deserves celebration as well as protection. For the past several months, our community has faced numerous barriers and hardships, simply for existing. Currently in 2023, the American Civil Liberties Union is tracking 435 anti-LGBTQIA+ bills in the United States. By and large the majority of those bills seek to restrict transgender and gender diverse individuals. That's at the state level - just as important are the local school board policies being enacted that target our queer youth.

While the outlook seems bleak, we still remain hopeful for a more inclusive future.

and honor of supporting the 13th Annual Keystone Conference. This Celebration of Gender Diversity saw approximately 725 gender diverse people from across the world come together in Harrisburg to learn, to celebrate their identities, and to be in community. We witnessed the generosity of spirit as so many donated time, clothing and accessories, and even money to the Clothing Exchange we ran at the conference. We listened to the rallying speech of young trans activist Kai Shappley, the twice political refugee who has stood up to the Texas State Legislature against their attacks on trans youth. This past week we breathed a sigh of relief as a federal judge temporarily halted Tennessee's anti-drag bill. On Transgender Day of Visibility, rallies were held across the Commonwealth and the country by gender diverse people and those who love them.

We must not give up hope and we must not remain silent - we must act to protect our community, our family, and our friends. Here are a few ways you can help:

- We encourage and implore you to go to your school district's board meetings, even if you do not have children, because our queer youth need support. We must not allow those who would seek to segregate, isolate, and erase our trans youth to have more influence than those who love, affirm, and embrace them.
- We ask you to inform your representatives at every level of government that our voices and our lives matter and we won't be forced back into the closet, nor will we be erased from public life.
  - We invite you to come join us at local school diversity events and at community events this month and to wear your Pride colors proudly.


