

Today is World AIDS Day



First observed in 1988, World AIDS Day is annually recognized on December 1st as a day to unify in the fight against HIV and remember those lost to AIDS-related

people to unite globally to eliminate the disparities and inequities that create barriers to HIV testing, prevention, and access to HIV care.

HIV continues to be a global health crisis, but it is no longer a death sentence. There is treatment that allows people living with HIV to be undetectable and unable to transmit the virus and to live long and fulfilling lives. There are also medicines that prevent HIV, such as the consistent use of pre-exposure prophylaxis (PrEP), which lowers the risk of acquiring HIV through sex by up to 99 percent. One of the best ways to reduce your risk of HIV and other STIs is to practice safe sex and to get tested regularly and know your status. Free testing is available in York County and surrounding areas. Education and awareness are important tools that bring us closer to ending the HIV epidemic.

To get more information about PrEP and other HIV preventatives and treatments, we encourage you to talk to your primary care provider. If you need help finding an affirming medical provider, please contact the Rainbow Rose Center.


Holding Space for Club Q

November 20th was a terribly sad day, not only because we honored the 70 gender diverse lives lost to violence on Transgender Day of Remembrance, but because senseless violence and bigotry again impacted our sibling community in Colorado.

We have wept with sorrow and risen in solidarity with our LGBTQIA+ siblings in Colorado Springs. We continue to hold space for the five individuals murdered and those injured at Club Q. We remember Raymond Green Vance (he/him), Kelly Loving (she/her), Daniel Aston (he/him),

This violation of a safe space impacts every single one of us, whether we live our authentic lives openly or still wait for the day we feel safe enough to come out. Our board president, Tesla Taliaferro, spoke about this on Monday, November 28th, on WITF's The Spark with Amanda Arbor, Executive Director of the LGBT Center of Central Pennsylvania. The Rainbow Rose Center Board of Directors donated to the <u>Colorado Healing Fund</u>, which supports those directly impacted by this tragedy. Like many organizations throughout the U.S., we are taking proactive measures to keep our York County LGBTQIA+ community safe as we prepare to open our office.

Know that throughout our individual and communal grief that you are not alone. There is an entire network of support and a whole community here to embrace and affirm you. Our allies, open and affirming ministers, affirming medical and mental care providers, and the Rainbow Rose

You Have Been Heard!



On November 29th, the U.S. Senate passed the Respect for Marriage Act, providing a massive win for LGBTQIA+ families and moving one step closer to solidifying the freedom to marry for same-sex and interracial couples under federal law.

The bill, which previously passed the House of Representatives by a vote of 267 to 157, passed in the Senate by 61 to 36. Support poured in from both sides of the aisle, with 47 House Republicans and 12 Senate Republicans voting in favor of the bill. The bill is now back in the hands of the House of Representatives for a final vote and, if approved, will head over to President Biden to be signed into law.

We hope to celebrate the codification of the Respect for Marriage Act in the coming days, but it doesn't end there. Even after we protect the freedom to marry, it will be critical to continue pushing for federal nondiscrimination protections so our community is protected in ALL aspects of our lives.
