# City of York Council Meeting - Conversion Therapy Ban Ordinance

On July 18, 2023, a new ordinance was presented to the City of York Council requesting that they vote in favor of banning the practice of conversion therapy by licensed professionals in the City of York.

As many of you are aware, "conversion therapy perpetuates health and social inequities for LGBTQIA+ persons" and as such propagates and legitimizes discriminatory practices against the LGBTQIA+ community. More profoundly important, are the dangerous and harmful effects this so called 'modality' has on the mental health and wellbeing of LGBTQIA+ youth.

The City of York Human Relations Commission invites you to attend the next council meeting on August 15 to offer any comments or testimony in support of the Conversion Therapy Ban Ordinance.


